Non-governmental organizations

Report of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations on its 2026 regular session **AS ADOPTED**

(New York, 26-28, 30 January, 4-6, 20 February 2026)*Summary*

At its 2026 regular session, held from 26 to 28, and 30 January, and from 4 to 6 and 20 February 2026, the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations had before it 618 applications for consultative status, including 381 applications deferred from earlier sessions. Of the non-governmental organizations submitting those applications, the Committee recommended 214 for consultative status, deferred 361 for further consideration at its resumed session in 2026 and closed without prejudice consideration of 42 applications of non-governmental organizations that had failed to respond to queries by the deadline of two business days (48 hours) before the beginning of the Committee session. The Committee further deferred consideration of one request for acknowledgement of merger and two requests for reclassification of status. The Committee took note of seven requests for a change of name and one request by a non-governmental organization to withdraw its application for consultative status due to its dissolution. The Committee recommended to withdraw the consultative status of one NGO and to suspend the consultative status of another NGO for a period of one year. It also had before it 927 quadrennial reports, of which it took note of 760. The Committee heard seven representatives of non-governmental organizations.

The present report contains five draft decisions on matters calling for action by the Economic and Social Council.

By draft decision I, the Council would:

- (a) Grant consultative status to 214 non-governmental organizations;
- (b) Note that the Committee decided to take note of the change of name of seven non-governmental organizations;



(c) Note that the Committee took note of the quadrennial reports of 760 non-governmental organizations, including new and deferred reports;

(d) Close without prejudice consideration of the requests for consultative status made by 42 non-governmental organizations after the organizations had failed to respond to queries by the deadline of two business days (48 hours) before the beginning of the Committee session;

(e) Note that the Committee decided to take note of the request by one non-governmental organization to withdraw its application for consultative status.

By draft decision II, the Council would decide to withdraw the consultative status of one organization, at the organization's request.

By draft decision III, the Council would decide to withdraw the consultative status of the non-governmental organization Il Cenacolo.

By draft decision IV, the Council would decide to suspend the consultative status of the non-governmental organization Comité International pour le Respect et l'Application de la Charte Africaine des Droits de l'Homme et des Peuples (CIRAC) for one year.

By draft decision V, the Council would take note of the present report.

15. At its 8th meeting on 30 January, the Committee considered agenda item 4 (b), New quadrennial reports. It had before it notes by the Secretary-General containing 773 new quadrennial reports (E/C.2/2026/2, E/C.2/2026/CRP.2, E/C.2/2026/CRP.2/Add.1-43 and E/C.2/2026/2, E/C.2/2026/2 Add.1-13). The Committee took note of the quadrennial reports of 750 of the organizations (see chap. I, draft decision I, subpara. (c)). The Committee decided to defer consideration of the reports of the following 23 organizations:²

IV. Strengthening of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the Secretariat

16. At its 1st meeting, on 26 January, the Committee jointly considered the following agenda items: agenda item 5, Strengthening of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch; agenda item 6, Review of the methods of work of the Committee: implementation of Council resolution 1996/31, including the process of accreditation of representatives of non-governmental organizations, and Council decision 1995/304; and agenda item 8, General voluntary trust fund in support of the United Nations Non-Governmental Organizations Informal Regional Network. It also heard an oral report by the Secretariat.

17. The Officer-in-Charge of the NGO Branch, Ms. Birgitte Bryld, noted that civil society's voice and partnership with the United Nations was more crucial than ever. She emphasized that civil society brought invaluable knowledge, expertise, innovation, and practical solutions that were critical to addressing today's complex global challenges. Through the Committee's consideration of applications for consultative status and making recommendations, NGOs were enabled to participate actively in ECOSOC subsidiary bodies, other ECOSOC fora, and the wider work of the United Nations, thereby safeguarding their access to the UN system. She also drew the Committee's attention to the impact of the United Nations current financial situation on the operational capacity of the NGO Branch. She underscored that there was a real risk that the Branch might eventually be unable to fully support the Committee in accordance with the mandate of ECOSOC resolution 1996/31. She assured Committee members that the NGO Branch remained firmly committed to supporting and strengthening meaningful civil society participation in the work of the

United Nations and that the Branch was dedicated to providing the highest level of support to the Committee.

V. Review of the methods of work of the Committee: implementation of Council resolution 1996/31, including the process of accreditation of representatives of non-governmental organizations, and Council decision 1995/304

18. At its 1st meeting, on 26 January 2026, the Committee considered the review of its methods of work.

Other related matters

19. At its 9th meeting, on 4 February, the Committee considered agenda item 6 (c), Other related matters. It had before it a memorandum by the Secretary-General containing new requests from NGOs concerning a change of name (E/C.2/2026/CRP.7). The Committee took note of the change of name of seven NGOs (see chap. I, draft decision I, subpara. (b)).

VI. Consideration of special reports and complaints by Member States

20. At its 1st and 8th meetings, on 26 and 30 January, the Committee took up agenda item 7, Special reports. At the 8th meeting on 30 January the representative of Algeria introduced a proposal to withdraw the consultative status of the NGO II Cenacolo. The representative of Israel made a motion to take no action on the proposal to withdraw the consultative status of the NGO II Cenacolo at that session of the Committee, within the context of Rule 50 of the ECOSOC rules of procedure. By 11 votes to 4 (1 abstention), the motion for no action was rejected. Israel requested a vote on the proposal made by Algeria to withdraw the consultative status of the NGO. The Committee by a roll call vote of 11 to 4 with 1 abstention adopted the proposal to withdraw the consultative status of the NGO. The representative of Algeria introduced a proposal to suspend the consultative status of the NGO Comité International pour le Respect et l'Application de la Charte Africaine des Droits de l'Homme et des Peuples (CIRAC) for one year. Israel requested a vote on the proposal made by Algeria. The Committee, by a roll call vote of 11 to 4 (1 abstention), adopted the proposal to suspend the consultative status of the NGO for one year.

21. The representative of Cuba noted that on the basis of the procedures established in ECOSOC resolution 1996/31 more than 6,000 organizations whose activities correspond to the purposes and principles of the United Nations enjoyed consultative status with ECOSOC and actively participated in processes at the United Nations. He added that the Committee each year considered hundreds of organizations that requested consultative status. Members of the Committee rigorously analyzed the cases under consideration. He expressed regret that on occasions there were attempts to disguise organizations that actively contravened the requirements established in resolution 1996/31 as well as the charter of the United Nations. This practice undermined the legitimacy of other civil society actors that contributed to the work of the United Nations in the areas of peace, development, and human rights. He emphasized that paragraph 55 of resolution 1996/31 established that organizations granted consultative status by the Council should at all times conform to the principles

governing the establishment and nature of their consultative relations with the Council. Paragraph 55 also established that it is the prerogative of the Committee on NGOs to determine the extent to which the organizations had complied with or failed to comply with those principles and how they contributed to the work of the Council. Cuba had listened closely to the presentation made by Algeria on 26 January. Taking into account the provisions of paragraphs 57 and 58 of resolution 1996/31, as well as the severity of the matter in question, Cuba considered the formal concern presented by Algeria to be valid and had voted accordingly. He also emphasized that all non-governmental organizations must act in accordance with principles upon which consultative relations between non-governmental organizations and ECOSOC were based.

22. The representative of Bahrain stated that she delivered this explanation of vote after the vote regarding the vote to withdraw consultative status from a non-governmental organization and also to suspend the consultative status of another organization under this agenda item. The vote was based on the principle of safeguarding the integrity of consultative status and to ensure that all NGOs that enjoy this consultative status respect and comply with the relevant principles and norms, including those included in resolution 1996/31. She stressed that consultative status enjoyed by NGOs conferred clear responsibility, including the responsibility to comply with the purposes and principles of the United Nations and to fully comply with the framework governing the participation of NGOs within the work of ECOSOC and its entities. She affirmed that Bahrain would continue to work with members of the Committee to ensure the implementation of resolution 1996/31 to strengthen the credibility of the Committee and to strengthen the credibility of consultative status. She expressed support for the vital role played by NGOs in enriching the United Nations in various fields because the participation of civil society amplified the voice of civil society and allowed for more rapid access to information.

23. At its 11th meeting, on 5 February, the Committee heard a briefing by the representative of Philippines on the legal status of the NGO Transnational Anti-Organized Crime Intelligence Group, which had been recommended for consultative status at the 5th meeting on 28 January. At the same meeting, the Committee decided to reconsider the application by that NGO, on an exceptional basis, under rule 57 of the rules of procedure of the Council. The NGO was requested to clarify its legal status with the Philippine authorities.

24. At its 12th meeting, on 6 February, the Committee heard a briefing by the representative of Algeria on (1) the systematic practice of multiple representations by same individuals at the Human Rights Council in Geneva by four NGOs in consultative status with ECOSOC, which is inconsistent with the terms of reference set out in ECOSOC resolution 1996/31, and (2) a pattern of impersonation by one of these NGOs, namely Communication en Afrique et de Promotion de la Coopération Economique Internationale (OCAPROCE). Subsequently, the Committee decided to transmit questions to those NGOs and authorized the Chair to write a letter to the NGO Branch to remind NGOs in consultative status of the rules and regulations they need to follow given their status. The Chair would also ask the NGO Branch on behalf of the Committee to transmit these allegations to relevant UN authorities in Geneva to ensure that appropriate action is taken. The four NGOs in question are: Réseau Unité pour le Développement de Mauritanie ; OCAPROCE ; Réseau Africain pour le Développement, la Gouvernance et les Droits Humains (RADEGH); and Africa Culture Internationale (ACI).

VII. Organization of the session

A. Opening and duration of the session

25. The Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations held its 2026 regular session from 26 to 28 and on 30 January, and 4 to 6 and 20 February. The Committee held 12 meetings.

26. The session was opened by the Officer-in-Charge of the NGO Branch Ms. Birgitte Bryld.

27. In his opening remarks, the Chair of the 2026 session underscored that ECOSOC decision 2024/342 had introduced several adjustments to the Committee's working methods, including changes to the handling of lists, the scheduling of suspension days, and deadlines for applicant responses. In view of the milestone of UN80, that challenged every part of the system to deliver better, the Chair stressed that incremental adjustments would not be enough. He emphasized that the world had changed dramatically since ECOSOC resolution 1996/31 had been adopted. The scale, diversity and sophistication of NGO engagement had outgrown the Committee's current working methods. To maintain its credibility and effectiveness, the Committee must embrace a more ambitious spirit of renewal. The Chair emphasized that the goal was straightforward: a Committee that was more transparent, more predictable, more accessible for applicants, and more efficient for delegations. That meant streamlining repetitive procedures, using digital tools where they added clarity and speed, and supporting NGOs to provide timely, high-quality information. It also meant clear, even-handed time management in the room and tackling the growing backlog of deferred applications and reports. The Chair stressed that the significant workload underscored why modernizing the Committee's working methods was not an abstract exercise but a practical necessity. He indicated that he would work with the Bureau and with all Committee members during the informal working group to accelerate these reforms. He reiterated that the Committee and the UN as a whole depended on the vibrancy, diversity and integrity of global civil society. He called for UN80 to be the moment the partnership between Member States and NGOs was renewed, grounded in mutual respect, transparency, and constructive dialogue.

28. The representative of India emphasized that, as in the past, his delegation would extend its full support to the Branch and work with Committee colleagues to ensure that the regular session concluded successfully. He added that India had an active, vibrant and pluralistic civil society and that his delegation supported an inclusive approach with regard to the participation of civil society in the relevant work of the United Nations and fully realized the critical role of the Committee as an intergovernmental specialized body under the ECOSOC. The guidelines and processes for assessing the credibility of applications and seeking clarifications to enable it to make a well-considered recommendation to the Council were well outlined in resolution 1996/31. He stressed that his delegation was confident that, during the current session, the Committee would be able to uphold to the fullest the intergovernmental nature of the decisions it would take. His delegation would continue to support the established procedures and practices of the Committee and was committed to working with other delegations towards achieving this cause.

29. The representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland emphasized that the United Kingdom remained dedicated to upholding civic space and fundamental freedoms both globally and within the UN framework. He stressed that civil society organizations were essential contributors to advancing sustainable development, defending human rights, addressing a range of challenges from climate

change to conflict, and holding leaders accountable. He added that when civil society could engage freely and securely without interference, then society as a whole benefitted from their crucial input and factual evidence. This was particularly vital to strengthening the UN's ability to respond to the complex shared challenges faced worldwide. He expressed regret that these positive contributions were not acknowledged everywhere, and that there were ongoing efforts by a limited group of member states to obstruct or postpone the involvement of legitimate NGOs. Tactics such as politically driven questioning, repeated postponements, and improper use of procedural rules undermined trust in the Committee and resulted in unnecessary delays. He underscores that, as such actions contradicted both the intention and the principles enshrined in resolution 1996/31, which aimed to encourage, not inhibit, genuine collaboration between civil society and member states, the United Kingdom remained committed to supporting the accreditation of all bona fide NGOs. He added that, consistent with resolution 1996/31, the United Kingdom's evaluations would focus strictly on four criteria: (a) that the NGO was actively engaged and functioning, (b) that the NGO operated independently of government control, (c) that the NGO did not inflict harm on individuals, property, or the environment, and (d) that the NGO and its personnel adhered to the UN charter and refrained from politically motivated attacks or profiting from illegal activities. He encouraged all Committee members to review NGO applications with impartiality, with consistency, and with a collective commitment to fostering a secure, inclusive, and supportive environment for civil society within the United Nations.

30. The representative of Algeria noted that civil society was diverse, bringing a wealth of expertise, experience, and perspectives that strengthened the UN's efforts to achieve the sustainable development goals and social development. He stressed that the growing number of organizations seeking consultative status reflected their enthusiasm to engage with the United Nations, while also highlighting the need for responsible and effective participation. He added that NGOs with consultative status carried responsibilities under resolution 1996/31, including contributing constructively to UN processes and providing relevant information and expertise. The Committee had an important mandate, and all members shared the duty to ensure its work was conducted efficiently and fairly. He reaffirmed Algeria's commitment to engaging constructively in the work of the Committee in a spirit of cooperation and mutual respect and looked forward to a productive session that advanced the Committee's agenda and strengthened the partnership between civil society and the United Nations.

31. The representative of Israel stated that civil society played an important role in the international arena. She emphasized that the contributions by non-governmental organizations enriched discussions, provided important data, and facilitated voices from across the globe. These discussions helped better understand the needs of various groups, gave a voice to those unheard, and enabled member states to reach better outcomes, acknowledging global and local trends. She stressed that it was through the lenses of NGOs that the challenges at hand could be better understood and the adequate responses to tackle them were provided. Through its membership in the Committee on NGOs, Israel strove to create an inclusive space for NGOs at the UN. Furthermore, Israel collaborated with various NGOs on a regular basis in the context of UN activities in many focus areas, including through co-sponsorship of side events, receiving expert input, and conducting research. The integrity of the Committee on NGOs and the millions of individuals and communities represented by civil society ensured that the principles upon which the United Nations was founded were being upheld.

32. The representative of the European Union, in its capacity as observer, reaffirmed the unwavering commitment to a diverse, adequately resourced, and independent civil

society. She noted that meaningful civil society engagement was integral to the organization's capacity to deliver on its mandate and to translate global commitments into tangible impacts on the ground. Across development, peacebuilding, and human rights, civil society organizations bridged the gap between international norms and lived realities, ensuring that UN decisions reached the communities they were intended to serve. Despite the context of steadily narrowing civic space globally, the strength and credibility of multilateral deliberations depended on an openness to hearing independent voices regardless of potential differences of opinion. She emphasized that, as a subsidiary body of ECOSOC, the Committee on NGOs had a mandate to facilitate, not impede, NGO participation in the work of the UN. In reviewing applications for consultative status, the Committee must be guided solely by the general interest and by fully respecting the letter and spirit of resolution 1996/31. The EU remained concerned by the continued and unjustified deferrals of some NGO applications on basis of dubious arguments and repetitive questions. She stressed that such practices risked undermining confidence in the UN's engagement with civil society at a moment when trust in multilateral institutions was already under significant strain. The EU saw no justification for further delaying the consideration of long pending applications of a number of EU based NGOs, as well as by organizations from other regions that had been unjustifiably pending for a long time. She urged the Committee to grant consultative status to eligible organizations without further undue delay. She added that reform of the Committee on NGOs was both timely and necessary. In the context of ongoing UN80 reform efforts and a persistent liquidity crisis, enhancing the efficiency, transparency, and predictability of the Committee's work was essential. She added that a more effective accreditation process was a concrete and cost-efficient means of strengthening the UN's delivery capacity and institutional credibility. The EU also underscored the importance of robust and inclusive working modalities. The potential for hybrid participation to enhance equitable access, particularly for civil society actors from conflict-affected or resource-constrained settings, merited serious and thoughtful consideration as part of a holistic and comprehensive approach to the committee's reform. She underscored that the EU and its member states stood ready to engage constructively with all members of the Committee.

33. The representative of China stated that in recent years, the NGO Committee, in accordance with the mandate of resolution 1996/31, had efficiently and responsibly considered a large number of applications and quadrennial reports from NGOs, fully demonstrating the effectiveness of the Committee's current working methods. However, with the number of applications from NGOs on the rise, the workload of the Committee continued to increase, thereby manifesting the necessity of optimizing the relevant working methods. He emphasized that China supported the goal of improving the Committee's efficiency and its level of professionalism and promoting reform in line with the principle of gradual progress and consensus. He indicated that while the working methods were adjusted, the Committee's authority in granting consultative status must be upheld. He added that, at present, the UN80 initiative was advancing in an in-depth manner, and the Committee on NGOs would also hold its elections this year. To ensure the successful completion of the established agenda and to achieve the smooth transition of the Committee, China did not recommend having discussions on working methods in the informal working group in the short term. He emphasized that subsequent discussions on an adjustment of working methods should be based on the broadest consensus of the entire membership of the Committee and be advanced in strict compliance with the relevant rules of procedure of the UN. China attached great importance to the crucial role of NGOs in supporting the work of the UN and supported the NGOs in obtaining consultative status and participating in the affairs of the UN. He stressed that China always participated in the work of the Committee with professionalism, objectivity, and responsibility, took every

application for consultative status seriously, fully assessed the capabilities and qualifications of the organizations, and contributed to the effective mandate delivery of the Committee. He expressed hope that other countries could also fulfill their responsibilities, improve their level of professionalism, and carry out their work in an objective and impartial manner. He reiterated that China stood ready to continue strengthening its cooperation with the Secretariat and Committee members to fulfill their responsibilities and duties in line with resolution 1996/31 and promote the compliant and orderly participation of NGOs in the work of the UN.

34. The representative of Eritrea stated that her delegation firmly believed that NGOs could play a positive role in the work of the United Nations, particularly when they brought relevant expertise, professional capacity, and practical experience. In that regard, she emphasized the crucial responsibility of the Committee in carefully assessing applications for consultative status and engaging applicant organizations through substantive questions to ensure that those granted status were genuinely able to contribute to the objectives of the United Nations. She noted that there were thousands of NGOs holding consultative status, which reflected both on the increasing interest in engagement with the United Nations and the growing complexity of global challenges. At the same time, she stressed that this required the Committee to reflect on how NGO participation could be made more sustainable, focused, and meaningful. She suggested that it was timely to assess the nature of NGO contributions to consider what could be improved from the perspectives of both NGOs and others and to examine whether current platforms of engagement remained fit for purpose. She also suggested thinking about how NGO participation could be reviewed over time. The absence of any review mechanism in the Committee's methods of work risked reducing the overall effectiveness of NGO engagement, particularly given the high number of organizations in the system, which could unintentionally dilute the impact of those with most relevant experience and capacity. She also stressed the importance of achieving more equitable geographical representation of NGO voices and expertise. The limited participation of active NGOs from the Global South risked producing imbalanced perspectives and priorities within the UN process. Her delegation wished to recall that NGOs granted consultative status had the responsibility to uphold the purposes and principles of the UN Charter and to act in accordance with resolution 1996/31. She expressed concerns about what appeared to be an increasing politicization and instrumentalization of NGO participation, including efforts that focused on targeting member states rather than constructively contributing to the work of the UN.

35. In his closing remarks at the 12th meeting, on 6 February 2026, the Chair expressed his sincere appreciation to all Committee members, NGO representatives, and the Secretariat for their dedication, stamina, and flexibility throughout the two-week session. He reiterated that, at the outset of the session, he had underlined that in view of UN80, the Committee must be seen not only as a procedural body, but as an institution with a central role in shaping how the UN engaged with civil society in the decades ahead. The constructive and collegial spirit that guided the Committee's work, had reaffirmed that shared commitment. He reported that the session represented a substantial undertaking and emphasized that NGOs brought expertise, energy, and firsthand experience that helped the United Nations remain grounded in the realities faced by communities worldwide. He expressed hope that those recommended for status would enrich the Committee's debates in the years ahead. He also extended appreciation to NGOs that submitted timely written responses and participated in interactive dialogues, noting that addressing the Committee directly allowed members to better examine applications. He thanked members for showing respect to NGO representatives who had often traveled great distances to speak in person. He underscored that throughout the session, his primary focus as Chair had been to support Committee members in accessing clear, consistent information

needed to make informed decisions on applications. Accreditation to the United Nations, he stressed, was a privilege, not a right, and proper scrutiny was essential. At times, this required him to ensure that questions submitted on behalf of the Committee were framed in ways that enabled NGOs to respond meaningfully and fairly. His intention had always been to serve the Committee as a whole—fairly, impartially, and in a spirit of friendship and mutual respect. He emphasized that when allegations or concerns were raised regarding certain NGOs during the current session, Committee members approached them with the seriousness required. However, for the Committee to maintain its credibility as a specialized body, due process must be allowed to run its course, ensuring that actions were taken on the basis of clear information and with a fair opportunity for response. He stressed that this balance between scrutiny and fairness remained essential to the Committee's work. He observed that despite the ongoing liquidity crisis and reduced meeting time, the Committee remained productive and focused. This outcome reflected the strong commitment and flexibility shown by all delegations, particularly as updated working methods stemming from ECOSOC's 2024 decision were implemented. These changes, though incremental, signaled the beginning of a necessary shift. As he had stated at the opening, if the Committee was to remain fit for purpose, comprehensive modernization would be required in the years ahead. He reiterated his concern regarding the resource constraints facing the NGO Branch. If the Committee expected to implement more efficient and digitized working methods, manage growing application volumes, and uphold transparency and clarity for applications, then the Branch must be resourced to succeed. Modernization was not simply a matter of procedural reform, it required investment and a genuine change in working methods. He recalled that, in his opening, he had expressed confidence that, by working together in a spirit of consensus, the Committee could deliver a productive session and begin laying the groundwork for a more responsive and forward-looking Committee as the United Nations approached its 80th year. Delegates' engagement throughout the session demonstrated that this ambition was both realistic and shared, and he expressed hope that the informal working group would be used to work together on these objectives.

36. The representative of India noted that, due to the pace at which the Committee had been proceeding, one of the scheduled question-and-answer sessions had not taken place. He suggested that the Committee may wish to consider ways to anticipate when a question-and-answer session may be cancelled and how NGOs could be informed in advance. The Chair acknowledged the proposal and suggested that this matter be taken up within the informal working group.

B. Attendance

37. The session was attended by 17 members of the Committee. The list of participants was issued in document [E/C.2/2026/INF/1](#).

38. At its 2026 regular session, the Committee heard seven representatives of NGOs, who were given the opportunity to respond to questions raised by the Committee.

C. Election of officers

39. At its 1st meeting, on 26 January, the Committee elected Mr. Andrew Sigley (United Kingdom) as Chair of the Committee and Mr. Billel Hassani (Algeria) as Vice-Chair.

D. Agenda

40. At its 1st meeting, on 26 January, the Committee approved the provisional agenda for its 2026 session, as contained in document [E/C.2/2026/1](#).

VIII. Adoption of the report of the Committee on its 2026 regular session

41. At its 12th meeting, on 6 February, the Committee took note of the draft report and authorized the Vice-Chair to finalize the report with the support of the Secretariat and in consultation with the members of the Committee, as appropriate, with a view to its submission to the Council for appropriate action.

42. At its 13th meeting, on 20 February, the Committee adopted the present report.
